Novice

Prep

All-Star

This is the first division in cheerleading, ideal for beginners. It introduces the fundamentals to cheerleading in a 1:30 minute routine.

Serving as an intermediate stage, prep teams allow athletes to build up to the advanced skills required for allstar teams. There are fewer restrictions than novice, and routines are 2 minutes long.

This is elite-level cheerleading, for athletes with advanced skills and ability. Routines are 2:30 minutes and involve complex skills and choreography.

PRICING STRUCTURE

£40 per month 1 Class per week

All three class options; Cheer, Tumble and Dance.

Team Membership: £40 per athlete

This covers team costs such as music and choreography. It is a one off payment, to be paid on acceptance of team placement.

Uniforms: Estimated £140 per athlete Our brand new, bespoke prep and all star uniforms are estimated to cost £140 (this includes top, skirt/shorts and bow). Novice teams will have a variation of this uniform (also bespoke) at a lower cost. More details will be communicated shortly.

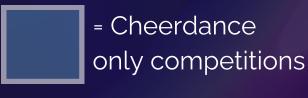

TRAINING KITS + CLASS DRESS POLICY

Team Apparel

We offer several items of team apparel including t-shirts, hoodies and onesies and these can be purchased directly from Rock the Dragon

Other items such as team jackets, jumpers, oodies and blankets can be ordered through your team coach directly.

Mystique training kits are new this season and can again be ordered through your coach directly. The training kit consists of crop top and shorts.

Crop tops = £25

Crop top + shorts = £40

Please note that none of these items of team apparel are compulsory.

Class Dress Code

Athletes are required to wear team colours (purple, blue, black or white) / mystique training kit to team training sessions. No jewellery or watches are to be worn at any training session and hair must be tied back securely. Athletes are to wear clean indoor trainers only.





CHERDANCE CLASSES

Cheerdance is also offered at Mystique, with classes for all ages and abilities. This style of dance is a fusion of pom dance, jazz and street dance, and is competed in solo dances, as well as duos and teams. In Season 7, Mystique will be offering three cheerdance teams, allowing all ages the opportunity to compete both solo dances and a team dance. Cheerdance can build athlete confidence with competing, while developing excellent performance skills. Athletes can choose to attend just solo classes, or both solo and team classes.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

Our attendance policy allows us to ensure that our teams remain competitive. As it is a team sport, athletes are adversely effected when team mates are absent, and team progression is hindered. This isn't meant to scare anybody, simply to inform that we are a competitive program. If you are not willing to commit to these attendance guidelines, a competitive team at Mystique may not be the correct fit.

- Athletes must attend all training sessions, unless authorised by program director; Fiona, in advance.
- Athletes must attend all competition dates.
- All important dates for teams will be communicated by your team's coach shortly after team placements, including choreography dates and competition dates (Although specific days/times aren't always available until closer to the time). If there are any issues with any of these dates, it is essential that you communicate these with the team's coach before the competitive season starts on Monday 1st September.
- 3 unexcused absenses within the season will result in your athete's team position being compromised.





1:1 / 2:1 SESSIONS

At Mystique, we also offer private sessions in cheer, tumbling and cheerdance. Prices vary, and both individual sessions and duo sessions are offered. These are bookable on Coacha. Please contact individual coaches for prices and availability!
